Dhananjay Ramchandra Gadgil, an Indian economist, institution builder and the vice-chairman of the Planning Commission of India, was the founder Director of the Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics.

His researches in the 1930s and 40s, were brought out as a book, the Federal problem in India by Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics in 1947. The institute published another of his work, Economic Effects of Irrigation: report of a survey of the direct and indirect benefits of the Godavari and Pravara canals, in 1948.

In memoriam of D R Gadgil, the “D R Gadgil Memorial Paper Presentation” is an initiative that sustains the passion towards research around the field of Economics amongst young individuals.

## Call for Papers

Manan 2021 - 22 invites papers from students in any of the topics provided below. Submitted abstracts will be screened by a panel of esteemed academicians. Students whose abstracts will be selected have to send their papers by 4th March 2022 and present it to a panel consisting of distinguished personalities from various fields on 13th March 2022.

The best papers shall be kept as a record in the Dhananjay Rao Gadgil Library for future reference. The papers may also be considered for GIPE's peer-reviewed Journal, Arthavijnana.

**ELIGIBILITY: Undergraduate/Masters/PhD in Economics or other closely related fields**

### **Guidelines for Submission of Abstract and Executive Summary:**

1. Participants must submit their abstracts and executive summary by 12th February 2022.
2. The abstract needs to be submitted in two pages. The first page should clearly specify the Title, Name of the author(s), and Name of the Institute currently enrolled in, the second page will contain the main body of the abstract. Maximum 500 words.
3. Executive Summary should include the projected findings and the possible results with a general idea of the model used in the study.
4. The summary should be a minimum of 2 pages.
5. Abstracts and the summary have to be in Times New Roman, Size 12, with line spacing of 1.5 and justified alignment.
6. There can not be more than 3 authors.
7. An author can send a maximum of one abstract for the presentation.
8. Submissions must be in PDF format. Word documents will not be accepted. Both, name of the PDF file as well as the subject of the mail must be Abstract-Author Name and Summary-Author Name
9. The authors of the selected papers will be notified by 19th February 2022.

**Note: On Selection of Abstract and Executive Summary, Participants are required to make a payment of Rs 500 as a security deposit which will be refundable on actual presentation.**

## **Guidelines for Submission of Paper:**

1. Authors necessarily have to send their Papers when their abstract is selected. Failure to which will eliminate them from the event.
2. There is no specific length for the paper.
3. Your paper must have a proper bibliography and list of references in a single format (MLA, Chicago, or APA)
4. The paper must be in Times New Roman, Size 12, with a line spacing of 1.5 and justified alignment.
5. The paper must have a cover page with the Title typed visibly and clearly and the names of the author(s) and their respective academic institute(s).
6. The cover page must be followed by a table of contents with page numbers.
7. The Table of contents has to be followed by the Abstract/Executive Summary and a list of abbreviations and tables or charts (if any) for the paper.
8. Submissions must be only in PDF format. No other format shall be accepted. Both name of the paper and the subject of the mail must be Final\_Paper- Author Name.
9. Each paper will be verified for Plagiarism. If detected, the author shall be disqualified from the event immediately.

## **Guidelines for Presenting your Paper :**

1. Authors will be allowed 15 minutes to present their papers. This will be followed by a Q&A session by the panel of judges.
2. There can be a maximum of 2 presenters.
3. Author(s) must be dressed in formals.
4. Author(s) are required to email their PowerPoint presentations to us by 12th March'22. No excuses shall be entertained regarding faults in the requests for downloading the presentations from their email.

**12th February 2022** – Last date for submission of the abstract along with an executive summary

**19th February 2022**– Announcement of selected abstracts

**4th March 2022**– Submission of Final Papers with registration fee (refundable)

**13th March 2022** – Presentation of papers
