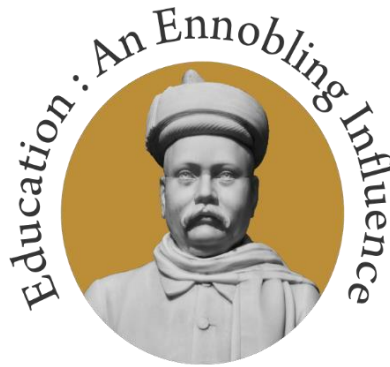

ABOUT GOKHALE INSTITUTE

Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics is one of the oldest research and training Institutes in the field of economics in India. Founded in 1930, with an endowment offered by the late Rao Bahadur R.R. Kale to the Servants of India Society (SIS). SIS was founded by Shri Gopal Krishna Gokhale. The Institute went on to have a rich history and academic research in areas of agricultural economics and rural development, population studies, input-output studies for planning and development, microeconomics, macroeconomics, monetary economics and finance, public economics and international economics.

The objective of the Institute has been to conduct research into the economic and political problems of India and to train research workers in these subjects. Furthering this cause, currently, the Institute offers various courses ranging from bachelors to masters and PhD programs, and by virtue of its expertise in research, often undertakes projects relevant to its core research areas.

The quality of research and education facilitated by Gokhale Institute today has been a joint effort of the current stakeholders and its faculty members. The road for such high standards in the current working of the Institute was paved long back by the first Director of the Institute, late Professor D.R. Gadgil, who prioritized the quality of research, teaching and training at the Institute in a number of branches of economics.

The Institute is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950. For its stellar contribution to Indian society in the form of research work, teaching as well training, the Government of India, on the advice of the University Grants Commission, awarded the Institute the status of a Deemed to be University on May 9, 1993. In the year 2016, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has reaccredited the Institute with grade A+, the highest accreditation rating of that time. The Institute has also been given 12-B status by the University Grants Commission in 2018.

About the Ph.D. Programme

In tune with the institutional vision and mission, the Institute offers a research programme leading to the Ph.D. degree in Economics, Agricultural Economics, Population Studies, and Law & Economics, Sociology, Public Policy and Sustainable Development. The Ph.D. programme is applied in nature and students are encouraged to choose research topics that have relevance to the socio-economic problems of the present day society. The Programme offers a compulsory coursework of 16 credits in one semester as a mandatory criterion for Ph.D. registration. The faculty of the Institute is having research interest in various fields of economics, population studies, public policy and sociology. Dr. D.R. Gadgil library of the Institute possesses around 2,80,000 documents covering all branches of knowledge. This includes bound volumes of 1875 journal titles, about 400 unpublished theses and dissertations and CDs, maps, etc. Besides books, the Library also receives 375 periodical titles. The library also subscribes to many online journals available to faculty and students 24*7 in the campus. Institute subscribes to all leading econometric and statistical software and leading database. Candidates who are recipient of UGC – JRF and other fellowships from Government of India and Government of Maharashtra can avail the same during the tenure of the fellowship. The Institute also offers teaching assistantship to all full time Ph.D. scholars with an attractive work profile and remuneration. Travel grant for presenting papers in national and international conferences is another unique feature of GIPE Ph.D. programme.

General Information regarding admission

Candidates must read the prospectus, procedure, and eligibility criteria before applying for the programme. The first and foremost requirement is that candidates must fulfil the essential eligibility criteria to apply for the Ph. D. programme. Candidates must note that the Institute will not refund the '*Application Fee*' to the candidates if they do not fulfil the eligibility criteria.

After completion of the admission process (document verification by the Admission Committee) in all respects, on the recommendation of the Admission Committee, the Institute will confirm their admission and admit the students with a temporary registration for Ph.D. Programme. Selected Candidates must undergo one semester of Ph.D. Course work of 16 credits at the Institute. Upon successful completion of the course with a CGPA of 5.5 on a ten-point grading scale, the candidate will be given permanent registration on the Ph.D. registration.

Declaration/Undertaking by Candidates

The candidates, who are admitted to the programme, require to give undertaking as per the UGC norms and Government of Maharashtra resolution at the time of admission/document verification without fail (**See Annexure I**).

1. Available vacancies for Academic year 2023-24.

For the academic year 2023-24, Ph. D. admission will be only for subjects Economics, Agricultural Economics and Population Studies. For details, please refer para 2 & 3.

2. Eligibility for admission to Ph. D. programme:

- a) Candidates who have completed:
A 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme in Economics/Agricultural Economics/Population Studies with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale (50 % for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS)/ DTNT/ VJNT and other categories of candidates as per the Government of Maharashtra Reservation Policy.)
- b) Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale (50% for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS)/ DTNT/ VJNT and other categories of candidates as per the Government of Maharashtra Reservation Policy) shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme.
- c) Foreign nationals/OCI card holders/NRIs will also appear the GIPE entrance examination with Indian citizens on the same date and time. The eligibility for such candidates will be as per the grade sheets equivalent to the 55% marks obtained at post-graduation level from the respective foreign universities.
- d) Candidates who have appeared for the final post-graduation degree examination during 2022-23 and whose results are awaited shall also be eligible to apply. However, in order to be considered for admission to the programme, their results must be conveyed by the candidates, or respective universities to the Institute, preferably by fax/speed-post, on or before **July 31, 2023 (Monday)**. Students may request their respective universities to dispatch their results to the Institute in a confidential form if the declaration of results is delayed beyond the last date stipulated by the Institute.

3. Number of Seats and Reservation

- The Institute will admit approximately a total of **17 (seventeen)** candidates to the Ph. D. Programme (Refer Table- 01).
- The Institute reserves its right to increase or decrease the number of seats in that academic year.
- The allocation of seats shall be as per the Government of Maharashtra guidelines, subject to the directives of the UGC/State governments as may be applicable at the time of admission.
- Presently, the Institute adopts the following percentage reservation policy as per the Government of Maharashtra:

* The DTNT/ VJNT category includes: De-notified Tribes (A)- 3%, Nomadic Tribes (B)- 2.5%, Nomadic Tribes (C)- 3.5%, Nomadic Tribes (D)- 2%.

**10 % EWS seats are included in General / open seats and reserved for the student's domicile of Maharashtra state only.

Note:

- **The candidates who belong to reserved categories of the other states will be treated as General category.**
- The vacant seats under the reserved categories shall be transferred to the open category after review.
- The Institute strictly admits candidates on merit rank, and hence, there is '**No ManagementQuota**'.
- The vacant seats under the reserved categories shall be transferred to the open category after review.

Important Note: 'Supernumerary Quota'

- The Institute reserves the right to allot seats for the candidates who are belonging to special groups if the Government of Maharashtra directs to allot special quota or seats additionally.
- The institute reserves 4 % seat in the programme for the Person with Disability (PWD) category supernumerary.
- The institute reserves 1% seat supernumerary under ORPHAN Children Category (as per Government Policy and Guidelines).

Additional Clarifications

- The percentage of unreserved seats may vary with the new guideline and reservation policies of the Government of Maharashtra/ Government of India from time to time.
- In case of any dispute, the decision of the Admission Committee or Admission Sub-committees of the Institute shall be final and binding on the candidates.
- The schedule, process and procedure of admissions shall be notified separately on the website of the Institute.
- The candidates must ensure to have all required mandatory documents with them before depositing “Admission Fees”.
- The Institute will not be responsible for any monetary loss of a candidate if he/she is not eligible for admission in any category/quota and he/she deposits admission fees.

4. Procedure for Admission:

The candidates who have qualified UGC NET/ JRF/ SET or M.Phil. with 55 % marks will be exempted from the GIPE entrance examination. They will be directly eligible for Ph.D. interview. All other candidates have to undertake admission through the GIPE entrance examination mode, followed by interview.

a) Ph.D. Entrance Examination

- The Entrance Examination will be of 100 marks with multiple choice type questions.
- Entrance Test Paper consists of 100 marks objective questions.
- The syllabus of the question paper includes research methodology, basic statistics, logical reasoning and basic mathematics.
- Each correct answer carries 1 Mark.
- There is “NO NEGATIVE MARKING” for wrong answers.
- The time duration of this entrance exam is 120 minutes.
- The medium of the Entrance Examination will be “English”.
- The Entrance Examination for Ph. D. programme will be conducted through center base online mode.
- Standard of passing:
General Category : 50% marks
Reserved Category : 45 % marks

b) Submission of Research Proposal

- Those candidates who are shortlisted for the interview will be informed in the website of the institute and via email by 30th June, 2023. They have to submit their Research Proposal by 15th July, 2023.

c) Personal Interview

- Candidates who pass the Written Test and candidates who are exempted from the Written Test shall be required to appear for an interview to present/discuss their research proposal/area of interest. The date and time of the interview will be communicated directly to the shortlisted candidates.
- Students who have secured 50 % marks in the entrance test are eligible to be called for the interview (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC/differently-abled category, Economically Weaker Section (EWS), DTNT/ VJNT and other categories of candidates as per the Government of Maharashtra Reservation Policy).

d) Exemption from appearing in Entrance Examination:

The Candidates fulfilling at least one of the following conditions will be exempted from Entrance Examination and shall be eligible to appear for Interview:

- a) Candidates who have obtained M.Phil. Degree of a recognized Institute through regular and not distance mode
- b) Candidates who have qualified at the UGC-NET (including JRF)/SLET/teacher fellowship holders.

e) Schedule of Ph. D. Programme

- The interview will be held in the last week of July and the selected candidates will have to join for the programme in the first week of August, 2023.
- The coursework will commence in August and will be completed in December (one full semester course).
- The Ph.D. Section will communicate through e-mail any updates, if so, of the schedule of classes.

5. Duration of the Programme

Ph.D. Programme shall be for a minimum duration of three (3) years, including course work, and a maximum duration of six (6) years from the date of admission to the Ph.D. programme.

A maximum of an additional two (2) years can be given through a process of re-registration on payment of the prescribed fees provided, that the total period for completion of a Ph.D. programme should not exceed eight (8) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. programme.

Provided further that, female Ph.D. scholars and Persons with Disabilities (having more than 40% disability) may be allowed an additional relaxation of two (2) years; however, the total period for completion of a Ph.D. programme in such cases should not exceed ten (10) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. programme.

Female Ph.D. Scholars may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave for up to 240days in the entire duration of the Ph.D. programme.

6. Part-time Ph. D. programme:

- The part-time Ph. D. programme shall be open to candidates working in academia / industry / research organizations, who are unable to pursue the doctoral programme in full-time mode.
- The working professionals shall produce a No Objection Certificate from the employer at the time of admission.
- **For candidates admitted to the Ph. D. programme under part-time mode, the pre- Ph. D. coursework shall be mandatory and they should be available at the Institute for offline classes during a semester coursework.**

7. Coursework:

- The Credit requirement for the Ph.D. coursework is a minimum of 16 credits, including a “Research and Publication Ethics” course and a research methodology course.
- The Research Advisory Committee can also recommend UGC recognized online courses as part of the credit requirements for the Ph.D. programme.
- After the immediate and successful completion of the course of one semester (16 credits), the students will start research work in consultation with allotted supervisor.

Structure of Ph.D. Course Work

The course work will be of one semester (August- December) duration with 16 credits and five courses.

A student has to qualify (non-F Grade) in each of the compulsory courses and the grade obtained would be used for final CGPA calculations. On the average, a minimum grade equivalent to 55%

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of marks has to be obtained by the student in order to be eligible to continue in the Ph.D. programme.

By the end of the Semester, I, Office of the Dean of Research and Publication will set up a RAC (Research Advisory Committee) for each student with the approval of Research and Recognition Committee (RRC) of the University and the Vice Chancellor.

Apart from these compulsory courses, if a PhD student wishes or his/her supervisor(s) or RAC members suggest to opt for any one course or more than one course of the Master Programme of the Institute in any semester, then students can register for the same as certificate course as per the existing rules governing Masters Programme in the Institute.

¹ Scholars who register under the faculty of Sociology, public policy, population studies and Sustainable Development may have to undergo a course in lieu of this course.

8. Registration:

- **Provisional Registration:** Candidates admitted to the Ph. D. programme shall be granted Provisional Registration. The date of Provisional Registration of a candidate shall be the date on which the candidate joins the Ph.D. programme in the Institute. The date of the Provisional Registration of a foreign candidate shall be the date of joining after obtaining valid student/study visa.
- **Confirmation of Registration:** The Provisional Registration shall be confirmed upon successful completion of the prescribed pre-Ph.D. course work.

9. How to Apply

- The Candidates seeking admission to the Ph. D. Programme shall visit the official website of the Institute: www.gipe.ac.in
- In the admission section, the candidates will see the details on how to apply and the process of admission.
- The Candidates must read the instructions and follow the same. Then, click on the appropriate link provided for the admission purpose on the web page.
- The candidates must fill application form online as per instructions provided therein and submit it online only along with the application fee of **₹3300/- (₹1650/- for SC/ST/VJNT/DTNT candidates) (Non-refundable). The Payment Gateway charges will be extra.**
- The candidates must pay the 'Application Fee' only through the 'payment gateway' by using a Debit/Credit Card or Net Banking facility (Please refer guidelines for the Ph.D. Application Form).

11. Reporting Time at Examination Centres

- The time of the examination will be communicated at the time of issuing the ADMIT CARDS.
- Candidates are required to report at the respective exam centres before one hour of the scheduled time of the Entrance Examination.

12. Announcement of Results

The result of the Entrance Examination will be uploaded on the official website of the Institute and displayed on the Notice Board at the Institute campus tentatively on **30th June, 2023**.

FEE STRUCTURE

The students are requested to refer to **Annexures II** for the tuition fees/other fees/deposits payable for admission to the Ph. D. programme.

As notified in **Annexures II**, Tuition and other fees shall be strictly payable in full for the whole year, only through online payment/payments gateway by Debit/Credit Card or Net Banking. In addition to the fees, the students may be required to bear nominal charges towards the study tours whenever the institute arranges such study tours.

HOSTEL ADMISSIONS

- The Institute has limited accommodation facilities for Ph.D. Scholars.
- The Institute shall provide accommodation on sharing basis for a period of three years subject to the merit and availability.
