Minutes of the Meeting of the Research Staff/ IQAC Working Group of Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics held on Wednesday, September 26, 2018

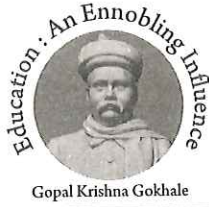


