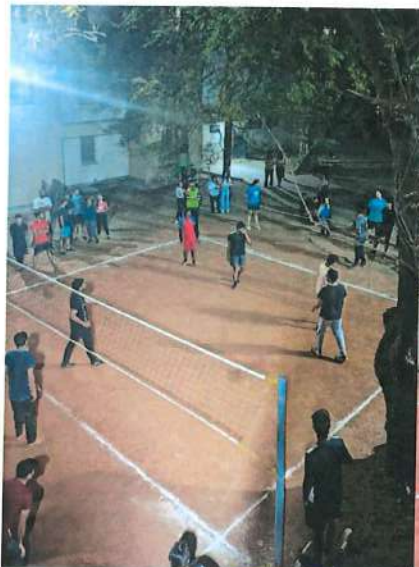


Volleyball

Seniors:

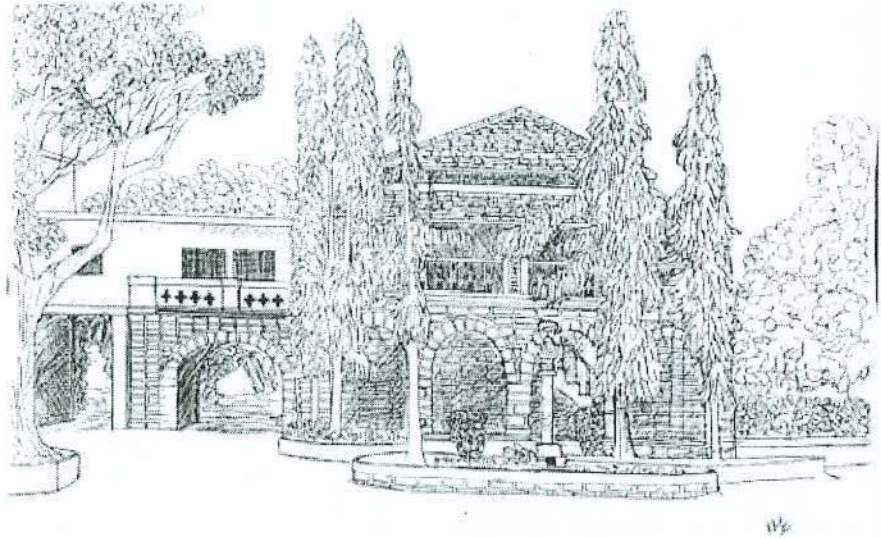

Academics:

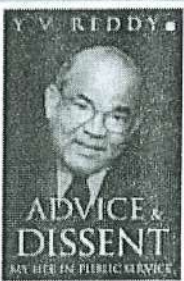

Life at Gokhale Institute: Tryst with Serendipity

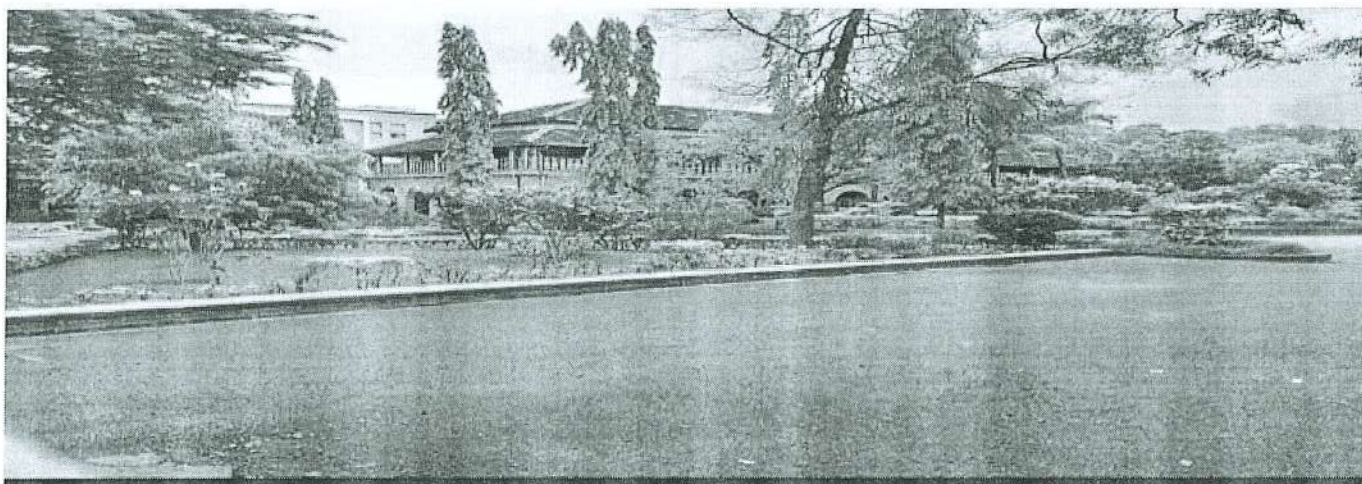

What's in the length of a skirt?

Hemlines, Heels and other strange economic indicators

You wake up, look into your wardrobe and you are faced with a familiar crisis - What should I wear?

And, as if the pressure of society's opinions wasn't enough, what if your choice had potentially massive economic implications?

The weight of the world, resting squarely on you picking a fashionable above the knee piece, or that cute boho chic full length skirt.

Sounds ludicrous, doesn't it?

Not to George Taylor, it didn't. In 1926, he came up with the novel 'Hemline Index', an economic indicator that used women's skirt lengths to predict or at the very least, indicate the current economic health of the market. The logic behind it was rather simple.

In those days, silk stockings were a luxury item. As the economy did better, women could afford to show off their fancy new silk stockings. As the economy began falling, women wished to hide their stockings (often repaired and rather worse for wear) or complete lack thereof under gowns.

His theory held the most weight in the 1920's, 60's and the 80's when the economy and shorter hemlines boomed together.

In fact, fashion is a surprisingly popular segue into economics and market health.

The High Heel Index is the latest to join the ranks. It postulates that the higher the heels, the worse the shape of the economy! In the event of an economic downturn, one doesn't buy too many pairs of shoes. It becomes necessary to make your purchases count. Consumers tend to go for the more versatile high heels over other choices. And why high? Classic over compensation, of course. As consumer confidence drops, heels go higher and higher. In fact, at the peak of the economic recession in 2009, the median height of heels reached a staggering 7 inches!

The other thing that gets longer as the economy goes down? Hair! The Haircut Index says that as a consumers' purchasing power and discretionary income reduces, their ability and willingness to spend

on things like haircuts goes down and results in most people putting off their haircuts till the very last minute. The Lipstick Index is another interesting indicator. It suggests that as the sales of small luxury items like lipsticks go higher, the economy falls. When consumer confidence is low and uncertainty about the future is high, consumers turn to small, attainable luxuries to give them comfort in rough times.

Is there any 'real' weight to these indicators though? Or are they just fancy, fashionable ways to explain away economic phenomenon to the common man?

The most comprehensive answer to this question was given by Marjolijn van Baardwijk and Philip Hans Franses in their 2010 paper titled 'The Hemline and the Economy: Is there any match?'

Where they took monthly data from as early as 1921 and all the way to 2009, they explicitly considered the fact that fashion takes time to design and produce and therefore took into account a lead and lag effect. Their results were astonishing. They realized that the Hemline Index actually bore weight, however, there was a lag effect of around 3 years. So the hemlines you see today are a reflection of the economy 3 years ago. A relation in the other direction (hemline to economy) was not found.

Though the idea that the very economy can be influenced by your fashion decisions is a power rush, it seems as though the economy is the one calling the shots when it comes to your wardrobe. In typical Indian style however, it's calling the shots a bit slow, with an approximate 3-year lag!

However, the subject of these indices is still open. One can freely assume that they have some impact until proven otherwise.

So the next time someone asks, What's in the length of a skirt, just answer... "The future of the entire economy apparently!"

The bright red dot in the night sky that sits on the shoulder of the familiar Orion constellation might be... dying. One of the brightest objects in the night sky, Betelgeuse, is a star in its red supergiant phase and has been in that stage for the past 40,000 years. During the last phase of its life, it will undergo a supernova, a phenomenon where the star collapses under its own gravity, resulting in a gigantic explosion. Betelgeuse is so enormous that if you were to replace our sun with it, the red giant would engulf all the planets up to and including Jupiter. The 8.4 million-year-old colossal star has been one of the most distinguishable stars in the sky because of its illumination and coloration. Starting in October 2019, astronomers noticed that the brightness of Betelgeuse has suddenly began to dwindle. The 10th brightest star in the night sky has slipped down to 21st place. The recent, dramatic fading has made scientists speculate that the star might be entering a pre-supernova phase. Some media outlets claimed the dimming was proof that the star was about to end its life in a spectacular supernova explosion. The dimming of Betelgeuse is not actually unusual. It is common knowledge that Betelgeuse is a variable star, meaning that its brightness fluctuates over time. Keeping that in mind, it is necessary to point out that predicting supernovae is an inexact science, so there is still a possibility, however little, that Betelgeuse's blazing end could indeed happen tomorrow. Or it happened 642 years ago and the light from it is about to reach the Earth. The distinctly red-colored star gracing the Hunter's shoulder that we see every night could very well be a "Ghost Star".

At a distance of 640 light-years, it would be the closest supernova observed and recorded by

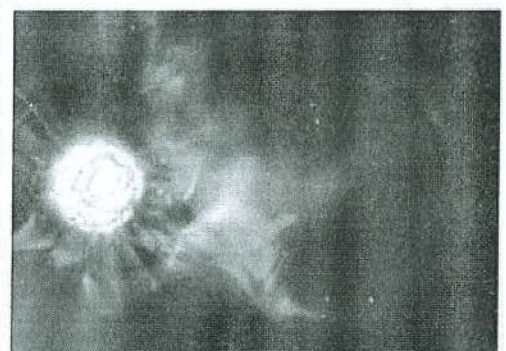
humans. But is it close enough to pose any danger to us? The answer is, no. The star is simply too far away from us to impact us in any harmful manner but when it explodes the flash would be as bright as the moon and also visible during the day for weeks following the explosion.

So will Betelgeuse explode in a supernova? Yes! But it is highly probable that it will not happen in our lifetimes. All the supergiant stars die as supernovae. Even though there has been a lot of speculation regarding the possible supernova of Betelgeuse, the scientists are of the view that the event could happen anytime within the next few hundred thousand years. However, one day Betelgeuse will explode and give us an astonishing cosmic show. It is sad that Orion will be left incomplete once Betelgeuse dies but hey, at least it will go with a bang!

I don't know about you but I'm definitely going to look up at the night sky to check if the crimson star is still there every time I go outside.
