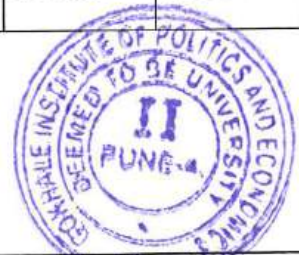
## Minutes of the meeting of the Internal Ph.D. Committee of the Institute held on Wednesday, January 20, 2021.

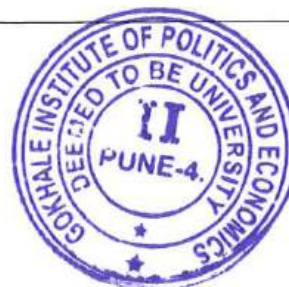
