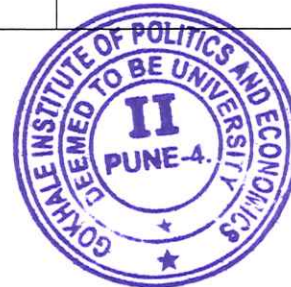


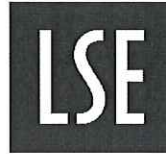

This is with reference to your application for the Teaching Resources Grant for college Teachers in Economics. The selection committee, which met recently, assessed your application and the outcome was a positive one for you. I am, therefore, delighted to invite you to spend one month at CDS. The following conditions are attached to this fellowship scheme:

- You may avail of the fellowship during any one-month period during April 2017 - Mar 2018.
- The Fellowship is limited only to academic activities of the scholar - CDS does not take any responsibility for any other activities/ engagement of the scholar during the fellowship period.
- You are entitled to return rail or bus fare from your residence (one time only), free accommodation in CDS Guest House for a period of three months, free meals in CDS Cafeteria will be provided, but for extras you need to pay on your own.
