## The Gram Jal Arakhada Nirman Project

The Gram Jal Arakhada Nirman Project & Water Literacy; inauguration program held on September 9, 2023, at the Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics in Pune aimed to address various aspects of sustainability, with a primary focus on water sustainability and water literacy for villagers.

### Aim:

The primary focus of the program was to address seven key areas of sustainability, including water, soil, green energy, developmental education, sustainable health, biodiversity and transparent village administration. The event specifically emphasized water sustainability and easy water literacy for villagers.

### Objectives:

1. Awareness: Promoting awareness through books and booklets.
2. Technical Training: Providing technical training from laymen to experts.
3. Actual Execution of Plans: Implementing plans through volunteers, regional heads, district heads, and mission coordinators.

### Highlights of the Program:

**Dr. Ajit Ranade**, Vice Chancellor of Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics, Pune officially launched Gram Jal Arakhada Nirman Project.

**Dr. Kailas Narhari Bawle**, Coordinator of Dhananjay Rao Gadgil Sustainable Village Development Centre, provided an introduction to the DGRD, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, and the Knowledge College Village Scheme. He discussed the vision of the National Education Policy 2020 and emphasized the role of educational institutions in collaboration with Panchayati Raj. Mr. Bawle stressed the importance of knowledge in solving problems. The Gram Jal Arakhada Nirman Project is a collaborative effort by colleges in Maharashtra to implement water conservation projects in villages, involving students and local communities.

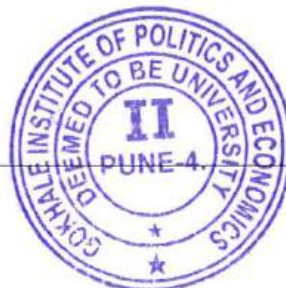

He highlighted the importance of water security and the need for action in the water sector. Spreading awareness among villagers in their vernacular language was emphasized. Various levels of technical training and methods for awareness dissemination were discussed.

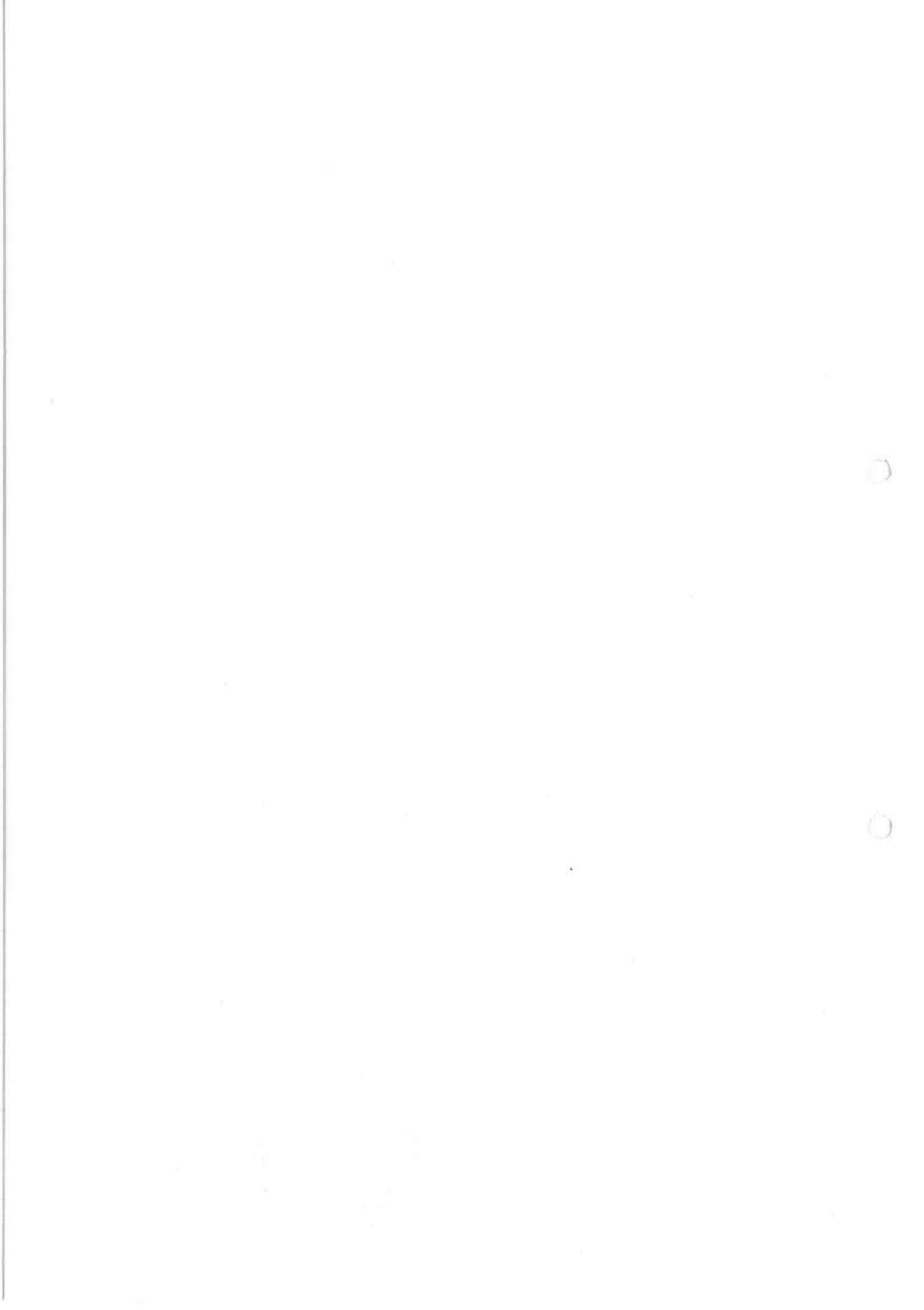
**Mr. Prabhakar Taware**, State Coordinator of Sahaj Jal Bodh, discussed the dependence on groundwater, the necessity of water conservation in Maharashtra, and the importance of water literacy. Groundwater storage and issues related to droughts and water pollution were also addressed.

**Dr. Gurudas Nulkar**, Director of the Centre for Sustainable Development at Gokhale Institute of Political Science and Economics, pointed out the high-water consumption and addressed water scarcity and surface water evaporation.

**Mr. Anil Sampatrao Patil**, Chairman of Maharashtra Development Centre and Member of the World Water Council, provided further insights into the topic. The program concluded with a question-and-answer session and feedback sharing from the audience.

**Mr. Pushkar Kulkarni** presented the vote of thanks, emphasizing the gravity of the situation and the importance of taking action.





The 'Gram Jal Arakhada Nirman Project' Inauguration Program was a resounding success, marking the commencement of an important initiative dedicated to water sustainability in Maharashtra villages. The event brought together key stakeholders, experts, and individuals passionate about the cause of water conservation, setting the stage for a collaborative and impactful journey ahead. As the project progresses, it is expected to significantly contribute to addressing the critical water-related challenges faced by the region. Physically, around 80 students and another 15 people participated in the program. They have joined around 238 students and villagers online. In 32 colleges. They have some places A group of people joined the online session; around 470 students joined this program physically, New Seminar Hall 95 and online joined students and villagers at 375. Total: 470 students join this program.

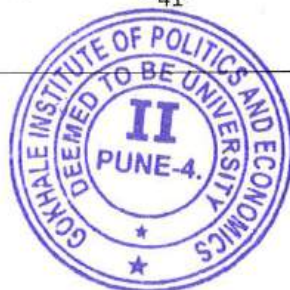
➤ "YOUTH FOR SUSTAINABLE VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT."



SIG volunteers started our 7-day NSS camp on 25th January 2023. The camp was in Karandi village of Pune district. We reached there by evening and we were allotted a school there for our accommodation. We were divided into committees or groups and each committee was assigned certain work on a rotational basis every day. The committees are food committee, cleaning committee, cultural committee, event committee, discipline committee and bonfire committee. Each group has one leader and my group leader was Anushree. Making our own food, doing social work together, collecting samples of soil and water, doing surveys, enjoying and participating in cultural events we all lived there like a family overcoming small difficulties and enjoying the happiness of doing things together. Through the camp, interaction with village people, and through surveys I have figured out certain

Problems of the village. They are the following:

1. Due to over cultivation of sugar cane, water table is going down which will create a serious water crisis in the future.





2. Soil quality is degrading due to excess use of fertilizers and pesticides and due to lack of crop rotation. We took samples of soil to test the soil quality.
3. Water quality is degrading due to excess use of fertilizers and pesticides and it may create serious health issues in future. We took samples of water to test the water quality.
4. Infrastructure push is needed in the village especially road infrastructure.
5. There is no primary health center in the village and it is needed because it will help the common people to meet their basic health needs.

We were tasked with monitoring the village's problems. The team made a number of observations because the majority of the families there rely on sugarcane production, which requires seeds to be sown every three years. The vast majority of them have homes equipped with automobiles, running water, televisions, cell phones, and other amenities. Wheat and onions were also grown there, but the main trade was in sugarcane, which was shipped to a nearby settlement to be processed into sugar. There were also milk collection centers where well-known corporations such as Sudia and Amul would collect milk samples to show customers the proper quality of milk. There are educational facilities up to the 12th grade, but many students choose to continue their education in other cities, particularly Pune. After talking with the kids, the team discovered that their main complaint is that there aren't many options in the curriculum and that the lack of appropriate grounds makes physical activities impossible. Despite their qualifications,



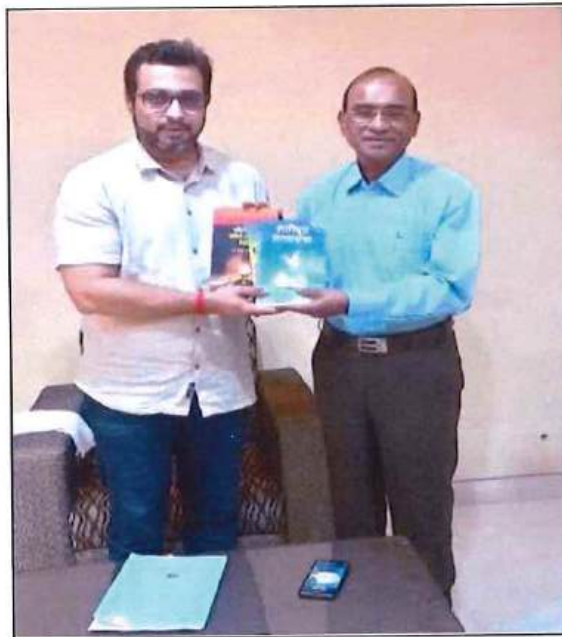

It was arranged during 23 March 2022 to 27 March 2022 in which students visited national level agriculture exhibition namely KISAN at Moshi, Tal. Haveli, Pune. During this survey period of 5 days 10 students of M. A. Economics studied three topics related to Indian farming as follows:

1. Awareness of government agricultural developmental schemes.
2. Drip irrigation: a water saving method.
3. Land Health a burning issue (Land Productivity)

To understand nature and intensity of these problems students interviewed around 2500 farmers. In the review meeting organized on 28 March 2022 students said that this activity helped students to understand grass root level socioeconomic problems, improved their communication skills and also boosted their confidence. Such community engagement programs will be arranged for students in future as well.

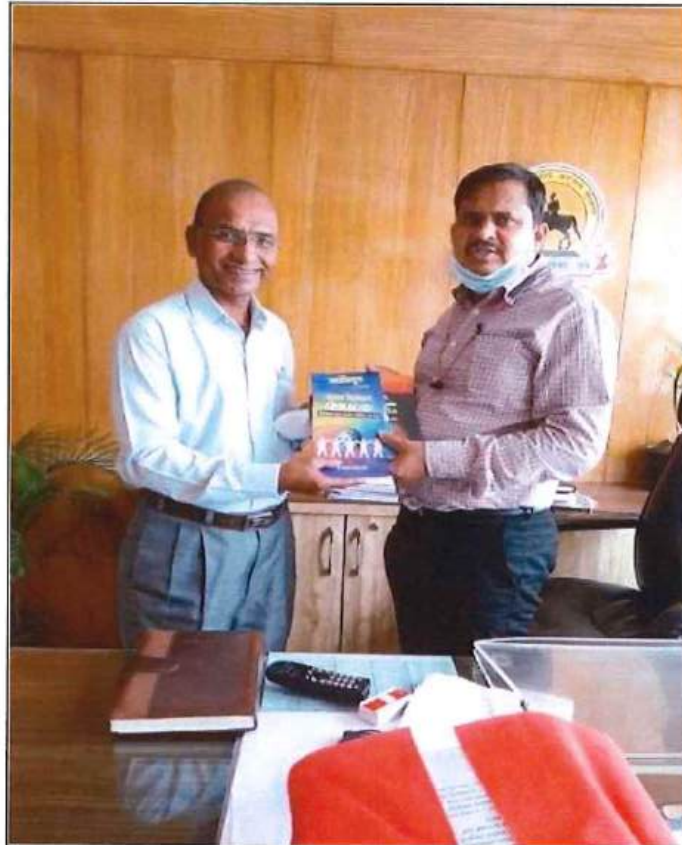

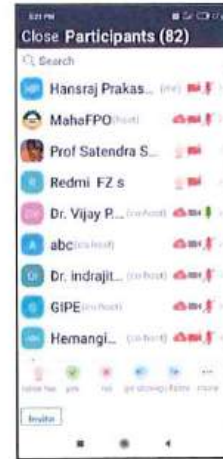
**I. Web series on Village Transformation:**

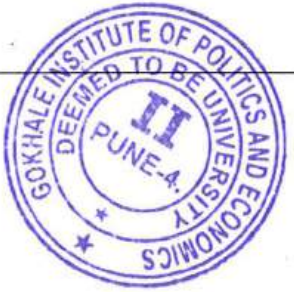
