

# **GIPE-CET 2025: Information Document for Students for admission in the MSc programme offered by the Gokhale Institute**

## **1 Purpose**

This document aims to inform students about the GIPE-CET 2025 entrance examination process conducted by the Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics (GIPE), Pune. It outlines the objectives, procedures, and other relevant details to ensure transparency and clarity.

## **2 Important Note**

At the outset, it is essential to note that this round of admissions is being conducted in the interest of students and the larger public good. It is not a right; no student can claim admission through this process as an entitlement.

## **3 Objectives**

The GIPE-CET 2025 is being conducted with the following objectives:

- To provide a fair opportunity to candidates who missed or could not appear for CUET 2025.
- To serve the larger public good by ensuring wider access to higher education.

### **3.1 Who can appear:**

- a. Eligibility: Please see the [Admission Brochure 2025-26](#)
- b. All aspirants who did not apply for or missed the CUET, but still wish to seek admission to the Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics (GIPE), Pune.
- c. All aspirants who may receive an admission offer from GIPE but would like to improve their chances of securing a seat in their preferred postgraduate program.

## **4 Admission Procedure:**

- a. The selection process includes an online examination (50 marks) and a Personal Test (interview) (50 Marks).
- b. Each stage will carry equal weightage in the final evaluation.

### **4.1 Entrance Test: GIPE-CET**

- GIPE-CET is an online, remotely proctored entrance examination.
- Candidates can take the test from any location of their choice, using a device that meets the technical requirements
- An AI proctoring system will ensure a fair and transparent examination process.

## 4.2 Exam Pattern Overview: Two Steps

### A. Written examination

- Total Number of Questions: **50**
  - Economics: **20 questions**
  - Mathematics & Statistics: **20 questions**
  - General Aptitude: **10 questions**
- Syllabus Level:
  - Economics & Statistics: **Undergraduate level**
  - Mathematics: **Class 12 (Higher Secondary) level**
- Duration: **50 minutes**

### B. Personal Test (Interview) Process

- After the online test, candidates will be called for an **online** Personal Test (**Interview**).
- Final merit will be determined based on performance in both the **GIPE-CET** and the Personal Test (**Interview**).

## 4.3 Merit and Admission

- Admissions will be offered based on the merit list and the candidate's program preferences.
- The Institute reserves the right to apply additional criteria while considering candidates who have applied through the GIPE-CET.
- The reservation policy of the Government of India will be strictly followed.

## 4.4 Conditional Conduct

- The institute reserves the right to conduct or not conduct the GIPE-CET for specific **Postgraduate (P.G.)** programs.
