1. How do I start the admission application process?

You must first register on the Institute's admission portal and create a Login ID.

2. What options will I see after logging into the portal?

You will see the following options:

- Main Admission Form – UG
- Main Admission Form – PG
- GCET Round 1 and GCET Round 2

3. Which form should I fill first?

You must first complete the Main Admission Form (UG or PG) for the programme you wish to apply for.

4. What information is required in the Main Admission Form?

You will need to provide basic personal details, academic information, and contact details.

5. Do I need to mention my CUET status in the application form?

Yes. You must indicate whether you have registered for CUET 2026.

6. What should I do if I have registered for CUET?

You must:

- Select “Yes” in the CUET status section
- Enter your CUET Application Number/ID
- Upload your CUET marks after the results are declared

7. When will I receive my Application Number?

After you complete the Main Admission Form and pay the application fee, an Application Number will be generated.

8. Why is the Application Number important?

The Application Number is required to apply for GCET Round 1 and GCET Round 2, if you wish to appear for.

9. Can I apply for GCET even if I appeared for CUET?

Yes. Students who appeared for CUET may also apply for GCET if they wish.

10. What information do I need to provide while applying for GCET?

Since your basic information is already available from the Main Admission Form, you only need to:

- Select the GCET Round
- Choose the examination centre
- Pay the required fee

11. Can I apply for both GCET Round 1 and GCET Round 2?

Yes. Students may apply for both GCET rounds by paying the application fee for each round separately.

12. Which score will be considered for admission?

If you appear for multiple examinations (CUET, GCET Round 1, or GCET Round 2), the highest score obtained will be considered for preparing the merit list.
